


# HOW TO APPLY

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTION

#### How to I apply?

#### Do I need to take any tests?

If you are a mature student entering high school, the school will take an assessment test.

#### How to apply to a school?

Make sure you apply at least:

- six months in advance if you want to study at a primary or secondary school,
- Fill out the application forms for the school or schools of your choice. Follow their instructions to submit them
- Health coverage for foreign students is different depending on where you live.
   Contact the school you are applying to for more information about health insurance.

# DOCUMENTS NEEDED

#### **Proof of Acceptance**

After the fees are paid, we will send you the Letter of Acceptance.

\*\*\* Please note that you should apply at least 6 months prior to the beginning of the semester. You can visit our website for the latest semester start dates

#### **Proof of Identity**

For proof of identity, you will need to provide a valid passport and two recent passport-sized photos.

\*\*\*Please note that when applying online a scanned copy of the passport will be uploaded. Once approved the original passport must be sent to IRC (Canadian Immigration, Refugee, Citizenship).

#### **Letter of Explanation**

This letter helps the visa officer to understand you and your goals. It explains

- why you want to study in Canada and
- that you understand your responsibilities as a student

You should include this letter if you decide to apply for a study permit, even if you don't have to get a study permit for your program.

#### **Proof of Financial Support**

You can prove your funds with:

- your bank statements for the past 4 months
- a bank draft that can be converted to Canadian dollars
- proof you paid tuition and housing fees
- a letter from the person or school giving you money, or
- proof of funding paid from within Canada

#### **REFUND POLICY**

Please note Application fees, Lawyer fees are non-refundable.

If your application is not approved, you will be eligible for a refund of the Tuition Fee, Course Resources Fee, and Health Insurance, minus any bank charges. To qualify for the refund, please submit the rejection letter. However, if you are enrolled in an online course, the Tuition Fee is non-refundable.

### What documents do I need to submit?

- -Birth Certicate
- -Passport
- -Proof of Address
- -Most recent Transcript

#### Do I need to take any tests?

If you have been going to an Englishspeaking school for over 3 years, there is no test required. However, if not, then the student will need to write the English Assessment Test.

#### How to apply at Z3?

Before applying, please make sure you speak with one of our admissions officers. They will give you a virtual tour of our school and what to expect. Once you have made the decision to join our school, you will need to pay the registration fees.

Please submit all the collected documents to info@z3education.com.

We will assess all the documents and provide a list of courses the student will be doing that school year. Once the tuition fee, course resource fee, and other fees (health insurance, lawyer fee, English test) are submitted we will provide the acceptance letter.
